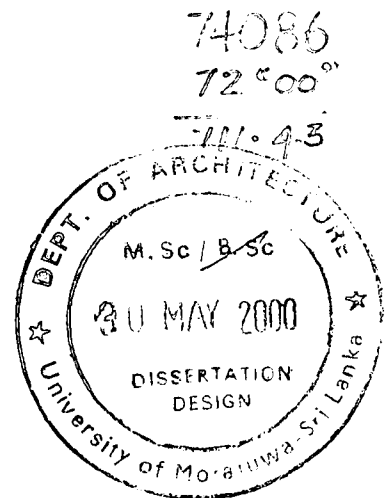
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ABSTRACT

The aims of this dissertation found the exiting fabric and what happened in the modern haphazard development and possible solution for these problems.

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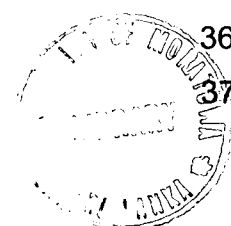


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
